### **DIRECT MODELS, Lanzo Bomber – by Brian Dowie**



My family gave me a Direct Models Lanzo Bomber ARF for Christmas. Well, really I purchased it and they put it under our tree.

The Lanzo is going to be used in Texaco and I have installed an OS 60 Open Rocker FS. Also I have installed two tanks to enable an easy transition from test running to flight mode (thanks to Fred Stebbings). This did require a little remodeling inside the front fuselage.

Overall I feel that the model is very well built and has a unique construction. An area I feel could be improved is the alignment of the Wing Platform and the Horizontal Stabilizer. Also, the platform is made from Balsa Sheet that could be made from thicker material. If this was made from a thicker stock it may improve alignment.

## **TOMBOY** by Brian Laughton


The following is a pictorial account of the construction of my Tomboy.
