MINUTES OF SAM 21 MEETING

MARCH 22, 2012

The meeting was called to order by President Brian Sargent at 7:05PM. There were 12 members present and no guests. The minutes of the February meeting were approved by voice vote. Treasurers Report by Lescher Dowling indicated the club was still solvent. Current total membership stands at 46. Lescher advised that we had received our 2012 AMA Charter. Additionally, he stated

that he had received funds from 2 members that were in excess of the annual dues. These 2 people were Dave **Bruner** and Gianco **Lusso** from Switzerland and the club thanks them for their generosity.

COMPETITION: Dave **Lewis** advised that the SAM 26 Spring Annual is coming up this weekend but only 2 club members are going to attend. He also advised a NCFFC FF/OT RC meet at Waegell Field is set for April 7, 2012. He reported that there were Fun Flies held at the Schmidt Ranch last year and several set for this year; unfortunately, there was never any flier or publicity so nobody knew they were happening. There is talk that a FF might be held this year at the Woodland-Davis field. Dave also brought up the club's semi-annual 1/2A Texaco/Speed 400 at Dwarfs Field. It is set for April 28, 2012, between 8:30 and 11:00AM. Bill **Copeland** will put something in the CLIPPER about this club contest.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Jake **Chichilitti** reported on the preparations for our annual contest at the Schmidt Ranch on June 8/9, 2012. He asked for comments about the question of combining classes (A Glow with A Ignition) and it was decided not to combine classes this year. Bill **Vanderbeek** gave an update on the participation awards. The flier for the contest should be out very soon according to Bill **Copeland** and will be mailed out. There will be a Saturday nite banquet, perhaps even Tri-Tip, with fresh Corn on the Cob, French-fries, etc.

Brian **Sargent** suggested we have a "Pizza Party" at our April meeting which is set for April 26. There will be a short meeting at the Saratoga Fire House and then several pizzas will be served. Again Bill **Copeland** will send out an early notice.

NEW BUSINESS: Bill **Vanderbeek** passed around copies of a model swap meet being put on by the Alameda Aer-O-Nuts on March 24, rain or shine.

Bill **Copeland** then brought up the subject of the cost of mailing "hard copies" of the CLIPPER to members. He figures the cost to the club of mailing out a copy of the newsletter to be about \$2.50 including stamps. A long discussion followed and it was finally decided, for now, to try to get members to receive the newsletters electronically, which is at little or no cost to the club. Dues will remain the same as they are now.

Noel **Eberhardt** gave a long talk about working with young folks to get them involved in building and flying model airplanes.

SHOW & TELL: Bill **Vanderbeek** passed around an altitude cut-off mechanism that cuts the engine when the model hits 600 feet or 30 seconds elapses. He said that SAM 27 people have purchased several of these units (\$70 each) and they are going to put on a contest event in the future for Speed 400 models.

Bill also showed the fuselage of his Cab Ruler, designed by Henry **Struck**. Bill pointed out that the landing gear unbolts and then folds up for easy storage. He will put a strong .19 ignition in the model.

Jake **Chichilitt**i showed his R/C Super Sportster biplane with a ST G-21 .47 and 10x6 prop. Jake crashed it on landing a while back and he has rebuilt it with four ailerons rather than just 2.

Noel **Eberhardt** passed around pictures of hang gliding in 1929 in Monte Vista. He also showed a system for turning plastic Coke bottles into clear plastic canopies using heat. The example is for a small glider.

Lescher **Dowling** showed pictures taken at the Zapatini Collecto in Fresno and advised that he sold his race car with a Rossi twin in it.

Steve Roselle passed around pictures of old French airplanes.

Spring Opener at Taft by Jake Chichilitti

I loaded up my van with five airplanes and headed down Hwy 101 to pick up Dave **Lewis** and his airplanes. What should have taken 30 minutes turned into a stop and go mess because of a gravel spill at Willow Road which closed the road for awhile. I finally arrived at Dave's place and we loaded everything into my van and headed out around 12:00 noon.

The trip to Taft was uneventful and we arrived at the flying site just after 4:00 PM. We could see cars and trailers set up as we drove up to the field and we sat around and gabbed with everyone before we went back to town to check in to the motel. The weather was warm and there was very little wind that afternoon.

Later that evening several of us went to a Mexican restaurant in town and had a great dinner. Then it was back to the motel to start charging up the equipment we were planning to fly the next day.

Saturday morning, after a quick breakfast Dave and I went to the field. Again the weather was perfect and it stayed that way all day. If I remember correctly there were twenty one registered pilots and there was quite a line of cars in the pit area.

I flew 1/2A Texaco and A ignition that day and managed to place second in both of them. I also flew old time glider and didn't place in that event. I think there were eight or so entries in that event and saw some of the best flying ever and some of the best looking old time gliders ever.

Dave flew in two events that day, I know one of them was Texaco and for the life of me I can't remember the other event he flew. Maybe Dave can add to this story. (see above results: Texaco, Antique, 1/2 A Texaco)

This event was dedicated to the memory of Hardy **Robinson** a long time member of SAM 21 and the contest director for their events. I met Hardy awhile back when I made my first trip to Taft and he was a real gentleman. I have only been in SAM for a few years now and the passing of our friends is happening way too often.

We knew that Sunday was going to be a lousy flying day because of the weather reports and for once the weather man was correct. We woke up to rain and it never stopped. Dave and I drove out to the flying field and it was decided by all the pilots that the contest would be cancelled.

The trip home was very pleasant. Dave is a wealth of knowledge which he shared with me on the drive. Thanks for the company; you're a good guy no matter what the others may say!

Petr Kolar sent me some photos of the new models he's preparing for the SAM Euro Champs'.


'I am attaching a couple of the glider photos. They are both gorgeous and excellent examples of the craftsmanship often seen in Europe'.
