Or is it?

Looking back at the 2013 flying 'season' is not all that encouraging. The number of 'actual' contests amounted to probably the fewest in history.

Counting the SAM 21 Ranch Romp, the SAM 27 Crash and Bash and the SAM 26 Spring Opener and John Pond Commemorative, there were only **four** formal contests in Northern and Central California. As recently as 2011 there were at least six. Just as important is the fact that the average number of entrants in each of these events was about 20 (e.g. the 2013 John Pond Commemorative had **only SAM 26** members competing).

Sure, several more or less organized 'Fun Fly's' were scheduled, and were what they were advertised as: Fun, but the question is: what can we expect in 2014? And, perhaps more importantly, what do we want to happen?

- Should formal contests be a priority?
- Should fun fly events be encouraged?
- What role might ALOT play in increasing interest/ participation?-
- Can contests in conjunction with SGMA events at Waegell be used by smaller Chapters as 'cooperative' SAM events?
- More restricted events (Speed 400/1/2 A for example) be scheduled?
- One design construction/Contest


I don't have the answers - do **you**?





FILM COVERING AND WINDSHIELD CLEANER: Courtesy of Bob Angel - SAM 26 Coastal Fyier

"I've used all sorts of liquid spray-on cleaners and lately had settled on a version from the 99 cent store as being as good as or better than the others for film covering. All have a drawback of requiring lots of time and patience, or you still end up with a slight oil film on the surface.

Tower Hobbies once had a 2 for one sale of spray-on foam cleaner/polish for film covering. So I gave it a try and it worked well. But the stuff came in stingy little spray cans, good for cleaning about three or four models, and was overpriced for the amount. That's probably why they had it on sale, because it was being discontinued.

Recently I found a commercial product in larger spray cans which does about the same job, and is the same or a similar product. It's called Spray Away, and comes in a tall, 19 oz can for about four bucks at some auto supply stores. One of our members also found it slightly cheaper in a Ralph's grocery store. Look for a blue and white can.

It leaves a drier, oil free surface in less time than liquid cleaners. It's actually marketed as a windshield and glass cleaner. I'd watched a technician use it to clean some windshields, leaving them streak free in much less time than does Windex or even Invisible Glass. But it is scented, and I hesitate to use it inside the house,

Since we're onto a theme of helpful household hints, here's the main secret of the highly advertised on TV "Invisible Glass": Use newspaper instead of paper towels to spread liquid cleaners and wipe completely dry afterwards. Paper towels have some residual goop (silicone?) that leaves streaks. Newsprint does not. Incidentally paper towels seem to work OK with Spray A way foam".

Gone West: Model Airplane Craftsman Franklin Robert 'Bud' Nosen

Credited With Bringing Large-Scale Model Airplanes To The Masses

Our friends at Lee Bottom Flying Field in southern Indiana posted in the blog NORDO News that Franklin Robert 'Bud' Nosen, who is credited in the model airplane community with bringing large-scale model airplanes "to the masses," passed away on November 13 at Solvay Hospice House in Duluth, MN.




Rich Davidson of Lee Bottom Flying Field wrote in the blog "If you ever flew radio control aircraft, or you still do, then I'm sure you know the name. I still wish I had kept that 1/4 scale Champ. I wonder where it is today?"

In an obituary posted in the *Duluth News Tribune*, Nosen was remembered as a husband and father of three.

He established Bud Nosen Models in Two Harbors, MN in 1970, and ran the business for many years.

The family said "In honor of Bud, please take an extra day to fly your model airplane, throw an extra cast into the lake, enjoy a long nap ... and be grateful for all you have." Nosen was 78 years old. The obituary said he succumbed to cancer. (From the web, courtesy "**Propwash**")


