

A) Boxcars Over Livermore: A little cool with cross wind, 14 entries, 13 flew

Made \$85 on impromptu raffle. John Eaton, SAM 51 won with a fly off time of 10.5 minutes, flying In a wave off the West end of the runway. He donated his prize money to the Flying Elec trons. Some drama was had with the sketchy barbeque volun teers.

Unfinished Business/Reports:

- A) Build/Fly Project: Copeland 2016 Project. Bill did not bring the spreadsheet which showed the San Jose in front with the Sniffer a distant second. The members decided to have a vote and declare a winner. It was unanimous for the San Jose.
- B) Proposed Electric Classes A.B and C: Brian Sargent Report: Brian had a lengthy discourse about setting new rules. It boiled down to using a specific battery and wing area as defining variables, with an 8 oz per square foot minimum wing loading for all. 325 450 = A, 455 to 675 = B, and 680 1460 for C. Greetings:

Arrghhh!, here I am, late again... Perhaps this is getting to be the new normal??

This has been another busy month for your **Ed**, much of which has been centered around trying to get all of the potential participants in the 2016 Build/Fly

San Jose project on the same page - actually 'with the same wing span'.

It seems a significant discrepancy has been discovered between the San Jose kit produced by Bob Holman Plans and the kit produced by John Eaton.

There is a significant difference of 6 inches In the wingspans shown on the plans and some cut parts furnished to early orders for the BHP were accidentally omitted. For a detailed description of the wing span problem see page 7. As to the cut parts problem, BHP has already produced and shipped the sheets of 'missing' parts. SAM 21 plans to distribute local BHP kits at their meeting on the 21st. See Special Note on page 1.

Suffice it to say that these issues have, unfortunately, delayed delivery of complete kits from BHP and JE is only now in the process of receiving the first run of his kits from the mfg. According to John, once he has 'proofed' the first run, subsequent production will proceed apace without delay.





The widely known, rich and famous, Frank **Womack**, SAM 30, sent these pictures of the King Burd and Peerless Panther examples he completed during his research for an appropriate candidate for the 2016 Build/Fly Project. The 'King Bird' made the list, the Panther didn't Nicely done Frank. Anyone want to argue over the final results of the democratic 'vote'?







Above, Left: In your **Ed's** opinion the King Burd looked OK in the three view drawing,, but seems overly simplistic and not a potentially good performer as it uses the flat bottom Clark Y airfoil. In addition the w/s shown is only 59 inches which would complicate kit production.

One of the objectives of the Build/Fly Project is to attempt to progressively increase the level of building skills with each new project. so that new builders can gradually become comfortable attacking construction of any SAM eligible model.

Right: In your Ed's opinion the low wing Peerless Panther is probably a good enough performer to be seriously considered, but not good enough to overcome the natural aversion of most modelers to avoid 'different looking' models.

It should be noted that Frank's version is seriously incomplete as it lacks a pilot figure...



San Jose One Design Project Update

Subject: San Jose Project Wing Span

Greetings:

Before anyone begins construction of the San Jose short kits, as furnished by Bob Holman, you need to read the following carefully...

During the course of ordering San Jose kits from Bob Holman Plans and discussions with John Eaton regarding his plans to produce a San Jose short kit, it became apparent that the two kits had different wing spans as shown on the plans to be furnished with the kits. The difference can be accounted for, but is too difficult to explain completely here, but to be fair a one design event should be just that.

The kits as ordered from BHP show the wing span as 68 inches. The kits to be produced by JE show the wing span as 74 inches which were based on the original plan by the designer, Alfredo Herbon, and notes the span dimension as 1880mm - or 74,021, a difference of 6 inches in span and according to John, 95 square inches of wing area. (which I consider significant in terms of performance)

Since the One Design series has adopted a nominal w/s of 72 inches, based on the performance of the Benny Boxcar, I feel the San Jose, at 74 inches, comes close enough and we have all found that the Boxcar at 72 inches performs very well.

Talking to Dave Lewis just now, he advises that the BHP kits have been received and will be delivered to those who have already ordered, beginning immediately. If you are on the list, do not panic as a simple adjustment to the BHP plan will be required to increase the w/s to 74 inches.

The "fix" will consist of adjusting the wing rib spacing to 2.96 inches on both the inner panel and the tip panel. This can be done on the BHP plan, or even better, JE has offered to furnish a wing plan only for a modest sum. John offers two options for builders to obtain the wing plan. 1) John will mail you a copy for \$8.00 or; 2) John will send you a full size pdf file from which you can print your own copies at no charge with the only caveat being that if your copies of his file cost you less than \$8.00 you send a contribution to John of the difference.- take your choice...

John advises that the first three kits are being cut as this is written and, assuming everything 'fits', should be available in the very near future.

I apologize for any anxiety, stress or required cursing this may have caused, and trust the right decision has been made. Remember, we're having **FUN**...




