SAM E-Flight ABC, New Class Testing Program.

Greetings All

This is an invitation for you to participate in an historic flight testing program designed to evaluate the viability of proposing a new event to the SAM rules committee.

After an abortive first attempt, which resulted in much confusion and consternation, the program has been reorganized with specific goals in mind.

- 1) To clarify the proposed rules for the event and;
- 2) To allow and encourage a rational approach to testing the concept by involving actual flight testing.
- 3) To determine a reasonable level of overall interest in this event

Here's where you might like to participate

If you want to join in, start by opening and reviewing a copy of the proposed rules and a copy of a form to be used to standardize the actual flight data you obtain.

We encourage you to **stick faithfully** to the rules so that accurate comparable results will be obtained. (we can discuss changes later.)

About using the time card:

- 1) The Card is designed to record all flights you undertake. Unless you are an 'over achiever', a single copy on heavy paper should be all you need. (feel free to use an additional card)
- 2) You can fly any time anywhere in any CLASS and add the flight consecutively to your card. You are encouraged to fly in as many classes as possible.
- 3) Please take the time **to fill in all data spaces for each flight.** (You may use 'ditto' marks, where appropriate, for consecutive flights with the same?? model.)
- 4) Recording flight times is optional, but interesting to the committee.

That's it! We sincerely hope you will participate in this pioneering program... (invite your friends)

Flight Test Protocol -

SAM 21 Proposed Special Electric Flight Events

The following procedures and record keeping shall be used to provide standardized data for the purpose of presenting a proposed new SAM electric event to the SAM Rules Committee.

1) All qualifying recorded flights will use dimensions, equipment and flight times as noted in the following criteria:

- Aircraft shall be electric powered, approved, SAM old timer design having a minimum weight of 8 ounces per square foot of wing area.
- Electric motors may be: permanent magnet, brushed, brushless, direct or indirect via gear or belt, speed reduction drive.
- No folding props.
- Scaling is allowed to the max number of sq inches within the chosen class limits, up to a maximum wing span of 120 inches for Class C.
- Models shall ROG.

2) The three classes will be:

- Class A: minimum wing area to a max of 450 sq in
- Class B: minimum of 451 sq in to a max of 675 sq in.
- Class C: minimum of 676 sq in to a max of 1470 sq in.

3) Batteries to be used for each Class shall be:

- Class A: 2S 1300 maH
- Class B: 2S 2200 maH
- Class C: 3S 1800 maH

(This is NOT the maximum battery size, This is the battery size to be used.)

Motor run times (all): 30 seconds.

Each total Flight time will be recorded

5) Proposed maximum flight times:

- Class A: 7 min
- Class B: 8 min
- Class C: 9 min




