

SCAMPS News

I'm happy my surgery recovery period has passed and life is resuming its normal tempo again. In my down time I fulfilled my desire to upgrade the *Joulebox 190* E-36 design to incorporate some changes I've been pondering plus some suggestions from others. I also finished CAD development of my second prototype version of my *Super 'Y'* P-30. I've not talked or shown much about this model-it's based on the *Yardstick* design but upsized and optimized for P-30, giving it a home in the competition world.

I actually had enough time before the end of my leave to build the *Joulebox* prototype and gave it a plastic film covering job this time. Power train started with the C20 Red Max motor as sold by Texas Timers. Also new for this design update is the ability to utilize either the Starlink-Flitetech or eMax electronic timers. eMax is



also marketed by Texas Timers and widely used for E-36 and other electric events. Early test flights with the C20 motor and 7.5 x 4 folder proved unmanageable for the amount of thrust generated by this combination-it popped from my fingertips like a rocket. I will be trying again using a 7 x 4 folder instead, which is what was utilized on my first *Joulebox* with great success. I've since installed the stock AX1806N brushless as provided in the *Joulebox* deluxe kit to get it trimmed under less strenuous conditions.

Kevin has been keeping us all informed of his father's condition and location as he continues to recover from the stroke he had back in March. Gary is being rehabilitated at the Palm Terrace Care Center, 11162 Palm Terrace Lane, Riverside, CA 92505. The phone number for the facility is 951-687-7330. Gary is in Room 2, bed B and at last report was open to visitors. If you can, stop by and say hello. Being in a facility like this is very hard to take-the more contact with family and friends the faster Gary is likely to recover. A friendly face is a huge thing when you are surrounded by strangers taking care of you most of the time. Our best wishes continue for Gary and a full recovery. And also to Kevin for all the burden he has on him now with his own debilitating condition not making it any easier.

SCAMPS Club Contest report Wednesday April 13, 2016 by Bernie Crowe

After several days of rain in the area, the forecast for this Wednesday was a pleasant 1 - 2 mph breezes throughout the morning. True, but we also had a pretty solid layer of fog hovering about 30 feet off the ground. The fog cleared by 9 o'clock and gave way to a pleasant flying day. However, the participation was poor, even though several were in attendance. The fact that no last-minute notice was given probably contributed to this, though the contest schedule had been published in the last four newsletters. I take responsibility for the poor communications, and will fix it as we move forward.

The power events for the day were OT ABC combined, and Perris Special. The only entry in OT ABC was Ron Thomas flying a beautiful *Hayseed* with an Elfin 2.49 (i.e. .15 cu in) diesel up front. Ron put up a max and almost lost sight of it in the fog, and decided to call it quits since he had already won. Ray Peel and Hulan Mathies duked it out in Perris Special, both maxing the first and last flights while dropping the middle one. The air at this time was tricky, as borne out by the times in other events. Ray edged out Hulan by 19 seconds, despite Hulan's plane sporting a genuine Sal Taibi signature on the wing!

P-30 was by far the most popular event of the day with five entries. Despite acting as CD (thanks Lance) Lance flew his *Square Eagle II* well, opening with a max, as did brother John flying a *Majestyk*. Mike Pykelny from the SD Orbiteers paid us a visit and flew a decades-old design, a *Hot Box* by the late John Oldenkamp. I flew my newly-built *Majestyk* (first contest!) and it flew consistently. I dropped the first round by short-DTing (!) and maxed the final. Ted Firster struggled with his *Tail Firster* due to an ailing front end, and switched to his Buddenbohm-designed *Shark Mk II* later in the morning. He managed two maxes and a 111 to take the win.

We had publicized the FAC Greve racer mass launch event throughout the year, but the FAC flyers must have forgotten about it as I was the only one there with a plane! I had a mass launch of all the Greve racers on the field (mine) at 10:00 and surprisingly won! Wouldn't have qualified as a FAC event with only one entry, but what the heck, I'll take it.

I was also the only entrant in F1Q. When we wrote up the schedule last December Kevin Sherman and I both wanted the event on the calendar, but with Kevin's continued ill-health and family health misfortunes, he obviously couldn't make it. So I won with one max, and have discovered my special way to win – schedule events where I'm the only entrant!

Next month: Mulvihill rubber, plus 4oz and 8oz Wakefield; AMA Gas; and E Nostalgia. Make a note!!
