### FEBRUARY CLUB MEETING

The February meeting of the Cloudclimbers was held at the Picadilly Cafeteria in Denham Springs. This was chosen as a halfway location for the time being, no one having volunteered for this month. Seven members were in attendance.

Carl passed out 2009 calendars to be used for event planning, and it could be seen there was a big gap between the February WinterCoupe and the Heart of Dixie meet in May. For the first order of new business, it was decided to host two club meets at the Simpson Sod Farm. The first meet to be Saturday, March 14, 2009, with a rain date of Sunday the 15<sup>th</sup>. 

It is popular to buy the taughtening nitrate dope, and cut it 50:50 with Nitrate thinner to store. Use this to attach tissue or as a sanding coat for all-balsa structures. For finishing, cut it 50:50 again with thinner and add 1cc of dibutyl phthalate plasticizer per ounce of thinned dope. Cost going the mail order route is about \$1.00 for 4 ounces if you buy quarts, even cheaper by the gallon. This is one-quarter of the hobby shop price.

There is an easy and inexpensive way to prevent ALL of your glue devices from doing what glue is supposed to do before it's supposed to do it. Pinch off a piece of modeling clay and pinch it over the end of your glue gun, CA pipette or CA bottle. I have left my glue devices for as long as six months and when I pulled off the clay they were ready to use.

## Frank Haines H-3 Firefly – 1937 Greve Trophy Racer

The 1934 Cleveland National Air Races added a new class of restricted cubic inch displacement engines into the line up. The Greve Trophy Races sponsored by The Cleveland Pneumatic Tool Co., manufacturers of aircraft landing gear components, honored it's President, Louis Greve. The race was initially flown in three heats decided by total number of points.

By 1937, the National Air Races were once more back in Cleveland. "The Great Lakes Exposition" was in its second and final year at Cleveland's lake front, attracting thousands of people from all over the globe. The total prize money available for the races was \$82,000, the highest to date. Attendance also set new records. Crowd's inside and outside the fence were estimated at well over 200,000.




### 1937 Greve Trophy Race 10 laps on a 10 mile course Total Purse \$15,000


