

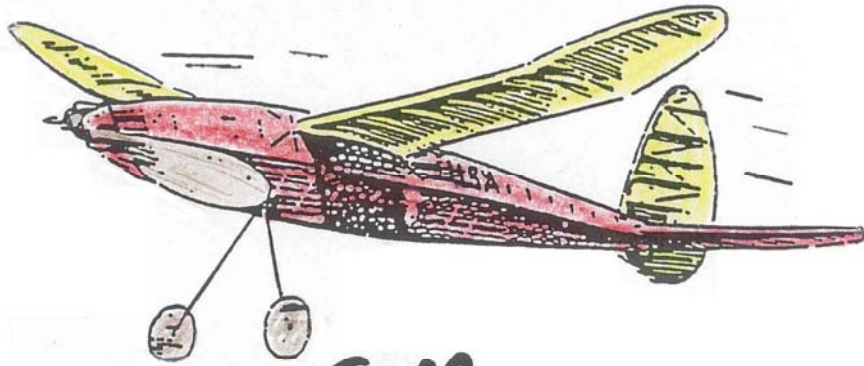

OUR THIRD GULF STATES ANNUAL

The Cloudclimber's third two-day Gulf States Annual, held November 8-9 at the great Pensacola Navy Site 8A, was well attended. There were 17 paid entrants, three more than last year. Doug Petty was the Contest Director, and Jim Bethea and Bob Thoren were assistant CD's. Weather was sunny with light winds.

The deal was that for \$20, an entrant could fly any event either day, as long as he or she finished on the same day. Events were closely fought, with Tony Piazza winning over Scott Cannon in SAM Large Stick/Cabin by a coin toss, and Bill Duke winning by a toss over Scott in FAC Old Time Rubber. In Catapult Glider, Bob Thoren tied with John Violette with 139 seconds so they had a shootout, which Bob Thoren won on last down.

For the first time, we flew a PFFT Model of the Year event in conjunction with the Cloudclimbers events. This year it was the Gollywock, and President George White offered cash prizes for First through Third places. Once again Jeff Brady donated a cooked lunch for a hungry crew, and soft drinks were also provided. Complete results on the following page. THE PFFT 2008 GATHERING OF THE TURKEYS

The Pensacola Free Flight Team had another successful Gathering of the Turkeys this past October 11-13. About 192 models flew in 36 events over the three days, making 550 flights. Doug Petty came away with a first in Nostalgia A Gas and Gollywocks Galore, and second places in Large Rubber Stick and Small Rubber Stick. Scott Cannon got a First in Small Rubber Stick, and a Third in Large Rubber Stick and Gollywocks Galore. Vince Burton won a First place in Old Time B/C Gas Pylon with his Alert, and a Second Place in A Gas Pylon with a Jersey Javelin.

A new event with 4 entries was the electric E-36 event, pioneered by Rex Hinson. Dohrman Crawford of the Thermal Thumbers won with 319 seconds, and George White came in second with 305 seconds. Your editor brought his new Sparks, but it was too windy to trim and test fly. If any of our readers would like to try this event, we recommend the excellent Sparky laser kit from BMJR Models. OUR 2008 CHRISTMAS PARTY AND 2009 PLANNING MEETING
