



CHEAP CYA ACCELERATOR: Someone passed this along and it makes sense. Dissolve a teaspoon of baking soda in ½ cup of water. You can then put it in a spray bottle, or just paint it on neatly where needed. Another thing I found is that you don't need the special higher priced accelerator for the special higher priced foam safe CYA. After testing, I found that you do indeed need the foam safe CYA for your little foamy airplane or it will melt and the wings will fall off. But regular accelerator doesn't seem to hurt foam, and the soda mixture will probably work fine also. Incidentally, foam safe CYA needs accelerator every time, unless you're willing to wait overnight for it to kick.

Bill Schmidt recommends that one checkout the Batteries America store (www.batteriesamerica.com) for batteries, chargers & accessories. He has been using the 2/3 AAA size in his latest 1/2A Texaco and ignition engine airplanes. The power output exceeds the old triple A Ni-Cad batteries of old.

If anyone is really interested I will be retiring my 1975 Honda 90 chase bike. I'm moving up to a TR200. The bike is in decent shape but is one of those that require the battery to be charged to run. That's a hassle. Call me if interested (722-7491). In chasing down the replacement, I managed to visit the Fargo Air Museum. Lightweight Viscous Timer for Free Flight models

Developed for use in rubber power models of all sizes, HLG, Catapult gliders, etc. It represents a basic methodology to provide a timing actuator to allow dethermalization of these types of models. Use as a starting point; experiment to create even better configurations, and share with the rest of the FF community. This timer is capable of up to three minutes or more, depending on tensioning setup, with two minutes the most consistent run time observed thus far.




