







P-30 Wing Dethermalizer set-up

Polecat X - Viscous Timer Retrofit D. DeLoach 2/2/06



This is a slick wing dethermalizer set-up developed by Don DeLoach. It blows the wing off in a straight forward manner. The diagram shows a viscous timer, but a fuse or radio DT could be substituted. The key difference is the use of a straw as a tunnel to run the DT string through the pylon to run the forward lever (rubber band hold).

Benton Airport Info & Direction






